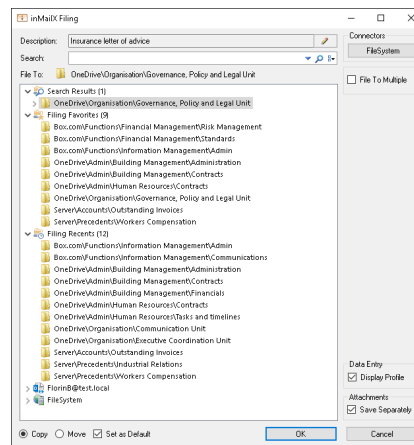
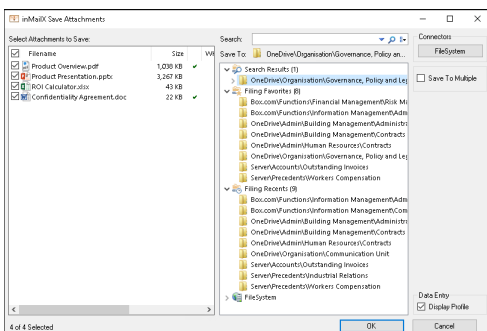
inMailX can be configured to force users to file their emails into cloud or network folders, mitigating risk and ensuring compliance with corporate policies.

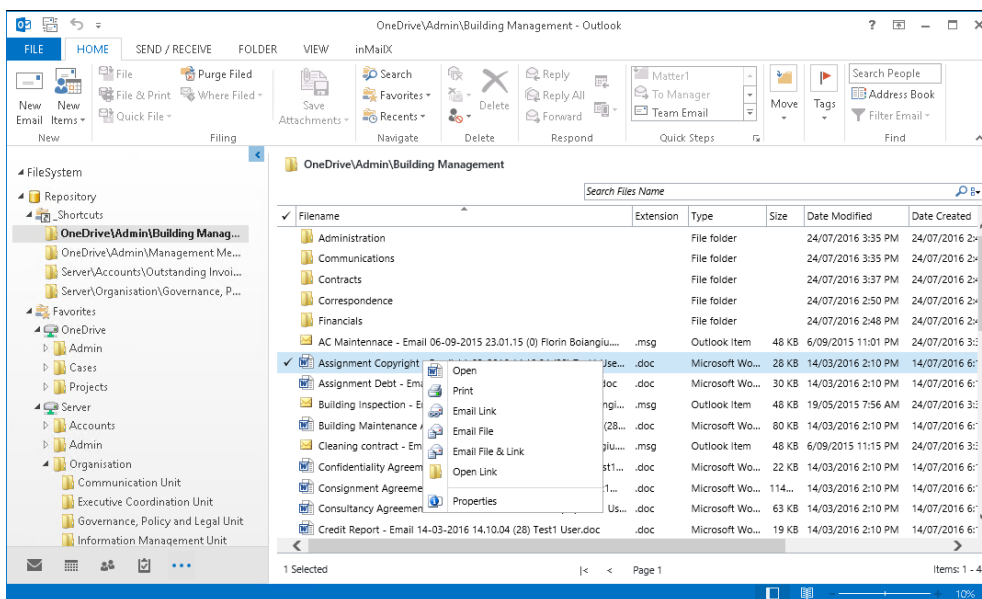
